Subject: **Availability of COVID-19 Vaccine Data in SFTP**

Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) has begun receiving files from the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) with COVID-19 vaccine administration data for our Members. We expect to receive **weekly file updates from DHCS on Wednesdays** and will load these to the SFTP as soon as received.

The COVID-19 vaccine data received thus far for your assigned Members is now available in the FFS files that are available to the IPA in the SFTP folder: /SPD/FFS Claims Data/.

COVID-19 vaccine data includes the name of the Provider who administered the vaccine and their NPI. The vaccines can be identified by reviewing for the following:

NDC Codes:

- a. 59267100001 = Pfizer
- b. 80777027310 = Moderna

CPT/HCPCS Procedure Codes:

- c. 0001A, 0002A, 0011A, 0012A, 0021A, 0022A, 0031A, 91300, 91301, 91302, 91303

In placing this data in the existing FFS files, **it was noted that most IPAs are not retrieving the FFS files that have been placed in the SFTP continuously since 2012 when SPD Members were rolled into IEHP.** This data is meant to provide information to assist the IPAs in coordination and continuity of care and should be retrieved from the SFTP on a regular basis. Please take note to incorporate the review of this data into your workflows.
