**Subject:** **REMINDER: 2021 Global Quality P4P Program- CAIR2 Participation Requirement**

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Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) would like to thank you for participating in the 2021 Global Quality P4P (GQ P4P) Program. There has been an update to the 2021 GQ P4P Program participation requirements.

**Providers are now required to be connected to the California Immunization Registry (CAIR2).**

Providers will be expected to be connected to CAIR2 and demonstrate entry of immunizations in the registry no later than July 1, 2021. **Providers who are not connected to CAIR2 by July 1, 2021, will no longer be eligible to participate in the GQ P4P Program.**

#### **Why Did IEHP Add This NEW Participation Requirement?**

- It is important that all Providers utilize CAIR2 for patient immunizations tracking. CAIR2 is foundational in centralizing patient immunization records, allowing all immunizations records to be accessible to Providers during patient care.
- DHCS is also adding this requirement for all Primary Care Providers as part of the Facility Site Review (FSR) Audit as noted in the All Plan Letter (APL 20-006).

#### **How Will We Know If Our Practice/Physician Has Met The Participation Requirement?**

IEHP will continue to send out monthly interim reports to show updates on Provider performance relating to the 2021 GQ measures. **There will be a CAIR2 participation status indicator added to the 2021 monthly interim reports, acknowledging that IEHP can see new immunizations submitted into CAIR2 by the Provider.**
