**Subject:** **New COVID-19 Vaccine PCP Incentive Program**

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Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) is pleased to announce the **New COVID-19 Vaccine PCP Incentive Program** to offer financial incentives to IEHP Medi-Cal PCPs. We appreciate your partnership in increasing COVID-19 vaccination rates in our community and our unvaccinated Members.

**Participating Medi-Cal PCPs (both IEHP Direct or IPA contracted) must have at least 50 IEHP Medi-Cal Members assigned as of October 1, 2021.** Enrollment into the program is automatic.

Questions	Answers
<b><u>HOW</u> do PCPs earn the incentive?</b>	<p>IEHP will pay <b>\$125 per *fully vaccinated, assigned Member, <u>vaccinated in your office</u></b> to PCPs who are registered with “myCAVax” and actively administering COVID-19 vaccines in their office.</p> <p><b>OR</b></p> <p>IEHP will pay <b>\$50 per fully vaccinated assigned Member to the Member’s assigned PCP</b> based on the assigned Member’s fully vaccinated status. This will occur when the assigned Member is not administered the completed COVID-19 vaccine series at their assigned PCP’s office.</p> <p>This allows for a financial incentive for PCPs who are NOT registered with “myCAVax” and not actively administering COVID-19 vaccines in their office at the time of Member’s COVID-19 vaccine administration.</p>

<p><b><u>WHEN</u> does the COVID-19 Vaccine Incentive Program begin?</b></p>	<p>COVID-19 vaccines given between <b>October 1, 2021 and February 28, 2022 dates of service</b> will be considered for incentive payment determination.</p>
<p><b><u>HOW</u> will PCPs be paid the COVID-19 Vaccine Incentive?</b></p>	<p>IEHP will provide a <b>lump-sum incentive payment</b> to all eligible Providers no later than <b>April 30, 2022</b>.</p>
<p><b><u>WHO</u> is included in the COVID-19 Vaccine PCP Incentive Program?</b></p>	<p>IEHP Medi-Cal Members ages 12 and older assigned to your office who have not previously been fully vaccinated for COVID-19 by September 30, 2021.</p>
<p><b><u>WHAT</u> can a PCP do to maximize earnings?</b></p>	<p>Identify Members assigned to your office who are due for the COVID-19 vaccine by visiting the IEHP Secure Provider Portal and access the Roster: “<i>COVID-19 Vaccine.</i>”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Discuss the COVID-19 vaccine with patients during visits.</li> <li>• Implement outreach calls to unvaccinated patients.</li> <li>• Host COVID-19 vaccination clinics.</li> </ul> <p><b>IEHP strongly encourages PCPs who are not currently registered to provide the COVID-19 vaccine to register to administer the vaccine.</b></p> <p>Please visit <a href="https://mycavax.cdph.ca.gov/s/">https://mycavax.cdph.ca.gov/s/</a> for details on how to enroll.</p>

\*Fully-vaccinated is considered **two doses of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines** or **one dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine**. Booster shots are not necessary to be considered fully-vaccinated.
