Subject: Major Organ Transplants (MOT) and TAR Approval DATE Impact

Effective January 1, 2022, per DHCS All Plan Letter (APL) 21-015, **Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) is responsible for coverage of the Major Organ Transplant (MOT) benefit for adult and pediatric transplant recipients and donors, including related services such as organ procurement and living donor care.**

MOT TAR Approval DATE Impact on Member Disenrollment Requests

- **If a Member has an approved TAR prior to January 1, 2022 AND requests to disenroll from IEHP, IEHP will initiate disenrollment.** The Member will be disenrolled from IEHP and the MOT will be covered by fee-for-service Medi-Cal.
- **If a Member's TAR approved prior to January 1, 2022, has expired AND the Member wishes to remain enrolled with IEHP, the Member will not be disenrolled.**
- **If a Member has an approved TAR prior to January 1, 2022, that has not yet expired, IEHP will confirm Member's desire to remain enrolled with IEHP.** If the Member wishes to remain enrolled, IEHP will proceed and take responsibility for the transplant.
 - **If Member chooses to disenroll, IEHP will initiate disenrollment and the MOT will be covered by fee-for-service Medi-Cal.**
