Subject: **Mandatory Managed Care Enrollment (MMCE) Phase II - January 1, 2023**

Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) would like to advise our Providers of the Mandatory Managed Care Enrollment (MMCE) Phase II changes effective January 1, 2023.

MMCE Phase II beneficiaries who receive pregnancy-related Medi-Cal services prior to January 1, 2023, will remain in their current delivery system through the end of the individual's postpartum period, until new aid code reassignment, or unless they request to be enrolled into a managed care plan. Newly eligible beneficiaries on and after January 1, 2023, will be mandatorily enrolled into managed care.

DHCS sent notices and choice packets on November 1, 2022 and December 1, 2022 to all beneficiaries who will be transitioning to managed care effective January 1, 2023.

Consistent with DHCS APL 18-008, Continuity of Care (COC) for Medi-Cal beneficiaries who transition into Medi-Cal managed care, and Duals Plan Letter (DPL) 16-002 5 COC, or any superseding APL or DPL, IEHP and its delegates are required to follow the current process to approve COC for beneficiaries who request it.
