Who are the eligible Members to participate in the D-SNP Model of Care Incentive Program?

This program offers incentives for services provided to IEHP's D-SNP Members.

Who is eligible to participate in the D-SNP Model of Care Incentive Program?

Independent Physician Associations (IPAs) that meet the following criteria:

- IPA must have a Medicare D-SNP contract with IEHP
- IPA must be in good standing with IEHP as validated by IEHP
- Actively participate in a Chronic Care Improvement Program (CCIP) Activity

What measures are included in the D-SNP Model of Care Incentive Program?

- Chronic Care Improvement Program
- Care Management Log Submission Timeliness
- Care Management Data Validation
- Outreach Log Submission Timeliness
- Outreach Data Validation
- Transition of Care (TOC) Log Submission Timeliness
- Transition of Care (TOC) Data Validation
- Individualized Care Plan (ICP) Completion Rate
- Interdisciplinary Care Team (ICT) Completion Rate
- Face – to – Face Visit Completion Plan
