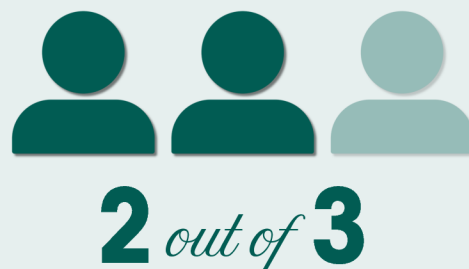
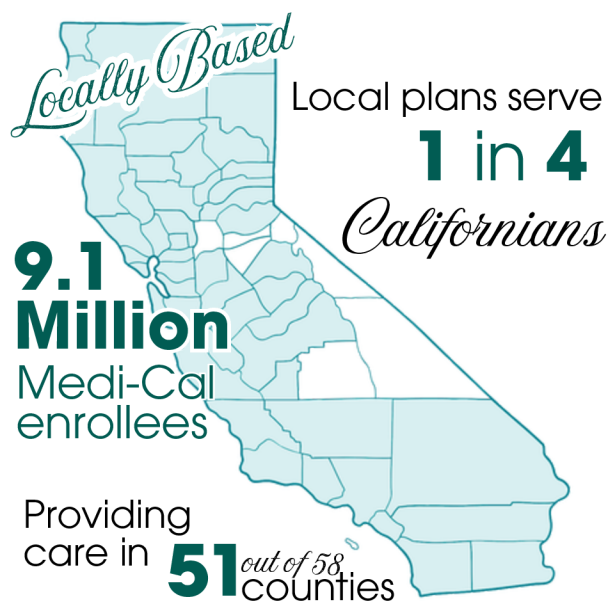
- Mission-driven, not shareholder-driven
