Helping you get the care they need

We're in this together

As a parent, you may have questions or need help with your child's growth and development. We're here to address your concerns and guide you through developmental intervention services.

Our team will make sure your child gets the care they need to grow healthy. This includes:

- **Case Management**
Navigating services to meet your child's needs.
- **Care Coordination**
Coordinating with other agencies for services and support.

Who is eligible?

- IEHP Medi-Cal members who are under 21 years old, recommended by a licensed psychologist or doctor, and are medically stable.
- IEHP Covered members who have a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

Symptoms to look for

- Not smiling
- Minimal eye contact
- Not responding to name
- Limited or no social skills
- Limited speech – few or no words by 16 months
- Upset at minor changes
- Showing repetitive behaviors (may look like lining up toys or spinning self)
- Delayed milestones

Get the care they need

If eligible, your child can get the following behavioral health treatment benefits:

- Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA)
- Social Skills
- Group Parent Training



Get started

Please visit your child's doctor. If needed, the doctor will send us a referral for testing.

Be sure to bring a list of your child's behaviors or concerns to discuss with your doctor during the visit. Also, bring any reports from your child's school, specialist or other providers. After that, we'll help you coordinate services and benefits your child may need.
