Subject: COVID-19 Vaccine Billing for Medicare Advantage Enrollees

Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) would like to remind our Medicare IPA partners that effective **January 1, 2022**, per CMS guidelines, delegates will now be responsible for the COVID-19 vaccine and its administration costs (including approved booster doses). There will be no cost sharing regarding this benefit.

Please ensure that your IPA sends reminders to contracted Providers regarding this change.

Additionally, IPAs are encouraged to consider in-home vaccine administration payments and other activities to reach homebound enrollees in CY 2022. Original Medicare began offering an additional payment amount for administering the COVID-19 vaccine in the home for certain Medicare patients on June 8, 2021.
