Subject: REMINDER: Dilated Retinal Exam (DRE) for Members who have Diabetes

We would like to remind you that the **annual Dilated Retinal Exams (DRE) for Members who have diabetes** remains a covered benefit for our pediatric and adult Members diagnosed with diabetes and is vital to maintaining and improving the health of our Members who have diabetes.

Annual means **once per calendar year**, but no less than nine months since the last DRE. If a comprehensive examination authorization is obtained, a DRE may be performed on the same day if the Member is eligible for the periodic routine eye examination.

PCPs can advise Diabetic Members to contact an IEHP Vision Provider (**not an Ophthalmologist**) in their area to schedule a DRE. A list of IEHP Vision Providers can be found at:

Prior to rendering services, Vision Providers are required to obtain an authorization for a DRE by submitting a DFE/DRE referral on the Provider Portal.

After rendering services, Vision Providers must use <u>the PCP Vision Report Form</u> to notify the Member's PCP of positive or negative results.
