Subject: AB 1797: Providers Required to Enter All Immunizations & TB Tests in CAIR2

Assembly Bill (AB) 1797, a new California bill effective January 1, 2023, requires Providers to enter immunizations and TB tests administered, as well as a patient's race and ethnicity, into the California immunization registry (CAIR2).

This reporting requirement includes, but is not limited to, newly recommended immunizations:

- Nirsevimab to prevent severe RSV disease for infants and toddlers
- RSV vaccines for adults 60 years and older.

Note: All PCPs participating in IEHP's 2023 Global Quality P4P Program must have connected to CAIR2 and begun entering immunizations by July 1, 2023 to qualify for 2023 GQ P4P incentives.

What are the **benefits** of CAIR2?

- Saves time
- Improves patient care
- Can forecast immunizations that are due based on ACIP recommendations
- Provides a central location to store and access complete immunization records
- Boosts immunization rates
- Can generate reminder/recall activities
- Can generate official immunization documentation record
- Helps Providers comply with the requirements of AB 1797, Medi-Cal, and the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program
