

### Does your child identify as Transgender or Gender Diverse?

Your child is not alone. The transgender and gender diverse population of the Inland Empire is about 27,000 people.\* At Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP), we want your child to get the care they need with the respect they deserve.

#### DID YOU KNOW?

- IEHP covers all medically necessary Medi-Cal-covered gender health services.

#### TIPS FOR PARENTS

#### Set up regular visits with your child's IEHP Primary Care Doctor

- If your child has not seen their Doctor yet, or in a long time, set up a visit today. Their Doctor knows their health history and helps make sure they get the care they need.
- Their Doctor can also refer them to Specialists. This includes any gender health options that are medically needed.
- Join your child at Doctor visits. Discuss with their Doctor your child's treatment goals, and be sure to allow them to express their feelings, too.
- Remember, you can change your child's IEHP Doctor at any time.

- Surgeries and Procedures (18 years and older)
