### CCA NCQA Health Equity Accreditation

IEHP achieved Health Equity Accreditation status from the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) for Covered California (CCA). This accreditation focuses on building an internal culture that supports the organization's external health equity work and identifies opportunities to reduce health inequities and improve care. IEHP received 100% passing scores for all assessed accreditation standards.

IEHP landed in the 100th percentile national ranking for overall provider satisfaction. IEHP ranked above the 98th percentile in every category from pharmacy to provider relations to call center. Most notably, 98.2% of providers shared they would recommend IEHP to other physician practices.
